The mission of the Connecticut Democracy Center is to inspire people of all ages to engage in civic life and strengthen their communities.

Founded in 1998, The Connecticut Democracy Center (CTDC) began operation as the Connecticut Public Affairs Network (CPAN) to launch the Connecticut Network (CT-N) in collaboration with the Connecticut General Assembly. The arrangement proved such a success that the Connecticut General Assembly extended another opportunity for CPAN to take over programming and operations of Connecticut's Old State House. This became a critical step in creating a "Lifetime Pathway" of independent civic education and engagement programs.

The Connecticut Democracy Center is a non-partisan, 501(c)3 nonprofit organization which does not advocate for any position or issue except the active, informed engagement of people from all points of view. While our partnerships with the General Assembly receive state contract dollars, no state contract funds support the projects included in our Community Partners Program.

Kid Governor® empowers 5th graders to change the world. It is an immersive and authentic civic education program that teaches state government, elections and voting, and civic participation through the annual election of a Kid Governor. Participants research community issues they care about, create platforms to address those issues, and make campaign videos. As adults head to the polls in November, thousands of 5th graders evaluate the videos of seven final candidates for Kid Governor and vote for the student and platform they support. The student receiving the most votes is elected Kid Governor. The six other finalists become their Cabinet. They serve a one-year term and work with the CTDC to fulfill their platform and to encourage students to make a difference on the winning campaign issue. The program is in residence at Connecticut's Old State House where the historic Governor's Office now serves as the Kid Governor's Office.

The CTDC created and launched the flagship Connecticut's Kid Governor® program in 2015 and now licenses this nationally recognized program to affiliates in New Hampshire, Oregon, and Oklahoma, with growing interest in other states.

On May 13, 1796, Connecticut's Legislature held its first session in their newly-constructed Hartford State House. Connecticut's Old State House is iconic in the City of Hartford and one of the first buildings named a National Historic Landmark in December 1960. WE THE PEOPLE: THE CITIZEN AND THE CONSTITUTION

We The People: The Citizen and the Constitution promotes civic knowledge and engagement among upper elementary and secondary students. Utilizing innovative materials developed by the Center for Civic Education, an entire class works in cooperative teams to prepare and present statements on six units before a panel of judges acting as a congressional committee at the state-level We The People competition. During the simulated hearings, students are judged on the following criteria: understanding, constitutional application, reasoning, supporting evidence, responsiveness, and participation. The Connecticut Democracy Center sponsors the Connecticut affiliate of We The People.

CONNECTICUT DEMOCRACY CENTER DEBATE TOURNAMENT

The Connecticut Democracy Center Debate Tournament hosts competitive interscholastic team policy debate tournaments for middle and high school students focused on a Connecticut topic. While participants receive preliminary resources, they are encouraged to conduct additional research. They use their research to develop negative and affirmative arguments, learn to cross-examine their opposition, and listen attentively to rebut their opponent's arguments.
